Chek Whyte reveals Eastside plans – exclusive

Cityrev, the Chek Whyte-owned company, has finally unveiled ambitious plans for a 50-storey mixed-used development in the Eastside area of Nottingham. The plans include a hotel, offices and 226 luxury apartments, with a supporting 21-storey building. CGIs from architect Ian Simpson show the BioCity logo on the supporting building, but chief executive Glenn Crocker this morning denied any involvement in the scheme.

Nottingham NDC boss suspended

Sam Tarff, chief executive of Radford and Hyson Green Neighbourhood Development Company has been suspended pending the outcome of an investigation. Tarff is also the chairman of the NDC network, the body which brings together 39 community regeneration partnerships. A spokesman for the Nottingham organisation declined to comment on why Tarff has been suspended, but confirmed that an external solicitor has been brought in to start an investigation.
